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Elements of the effective educational process from the perspective of university students

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Abstract

The study aimed to identify the elements of the effective educational process from the point of view of the students of Al-Balqa Applied University in Jordan and its relationship to the variables of gender and degree, where the descriptive approach was used in addition to the use of a questionnaire that consisted of 20 items that measure the elements of the educational process, and the study sample consisted of 1000 male and female students from Al-Balqa Applied University from various faculties and academic disciplines; Where the study showed that the elements of the effective educational process from the students' point of view came to a medium degree as a whole, and the results showed that there were no statistically significant differences in the elements of the effective educational process from the perspective of university students, which are attributed to the study variables, namely gender males, females and the student's academic degree Intermediate Diploma, Bachelor's; The study recommends the necessity of paying attention to the faculty member at Al-Balqa Applied University and developing his educational abilities and skills to serve the educational process in general.

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1. Introduction

Therefore, a member of the educational faculty is one of the foundations of the educational process, as no educational system can achieve its goals and successes without using it, so we find that its position must be distinguished as in developed societies, and because education is one of the most important goals and objectives of higher education institutions. Rather, it is one of the oldest and most practiced, as students are exposed to this practice in most days of their enrollment years and at all levels, and it is the main work carried out by faculty members in universities, and therefore the education process still takes wide interest from the university administration, and therefore seeks On a permanent and continuous basis to develop it by various means and provide it with all the necessary material and human needs for its development and success in a manner befitting the reputation of the university, because in the end it is considered the important indicator in order to judge the educational institution and an important and main factor for its classification and identification of its capabilities and capabilities to achieve the desired goals (Hastie, 2014; AL-Momani& Jawarneh, 2022; Grant et.al, 2019)

Based on what has been shown, the researcher any this is the study trying to get to know Elements of the effective educational process as seen by the students of Al-Balqa Applied University This is what is intended mechanism current search; Whereas, by reviewing the educational literature related to the subject of the study, and through the university researcher's experiences and his knowledge of the teaching-learning process and the continuous follow-up of the students, he noticed that there is a lack

of studies related to effective teaching in the Jordanian society, especially the university, so there was a need to conduct a study on teaching and education effective because of its specificity and importance; Through the researcher's review of the previous studies related to the subject of the current study, some of them were reached (Khazay, 2020) study aimed at Recognition teacher proficiency levelly Resource rooms for skills teaching Effective, the researcher used the method descriptive The researcher used the observations a tool To reach the results of the study, which was divided into three dimensions planning, and teaching classroom management, and calendar The study population consisted of (50) teachers, and the researcher reached several results, the most important of which are: The level of their mastery of the skills teaching moderately, while There are no significant differences Statistic Attributed to years of experience.

As a study came (Asiri; 2013) which I aimed to get to know you on me teacher practice level and math teachers for styles teaching effective schools Primary city Najran, and the researcher used the method descriptive, The questionnaire was used as a tool for the study. And formed study sample From(408) a teacher and his teacher, and the researcher concluded that the level of performance of a teachers Mathematics for skill planning and implement teaching and skill Calendar Investigation and solving skill the problems was a degree High, while There are significant differences Statistic be consoled for variables Years' Experience and qualification Scientific.

2. the study Problem:

Through the work of the researcher As a faculty member at Al-Balqa Applied University in Jordan and close to the operation educational Emphasizes the need to know Elements of the educational process From the point of view Students so try To find out the weaknesses and short comings and present The solutions are for her, that's why they lie the study Problem in Answer the questions next:

- 1- What are the elements of the effective teaching and learning process from the point of view of Al-Balqa Applied University students?
- 2- Are there any statistically significant differences at the level of significance (α = 0.05) in the elements of the effective teaching and learning process from the point of view of Al-Balqa Applied University students, which are attributed to the gender variable (male, female)?
- 3- Are there any statistically significant differences at the level of significance ($\alpha = 0.05$) in the elements of the effective educational and teaching process from the point of view of Al-Balqa Applied University students, which are attributed to the degree variable (intermediate diploma, bachelor's)?

3. the importance of studying:

The importance of the study appears in Identify the short comings and weaknesses in skills teaching effective at Faculty members at Al-Balqa Applied University which contributes toy Selection Software training The occasion by the centers Training faculty members; as well as contributory help faculty member Focus on skills teaching The effective must have teachers at the university.

4. Objectives of the study:

The study aimed to identify:

- 1- Identifying the elements of the effective teaching and learning process from the perspective of Al-Balqa Applied University students.
- 2- Identifying the impact of the variables of gender and academic degree of the university student on the elements of the effective teaching and learning process from the students' point of view.

5. Study limitations:

The study was limited to the following:

- 1- Spatial domain: a sample of Al-Balqa Applied University students.
- 2- Human field: This study was limited to university students enrolled in the intermediate diploma and bachelor's stages from various faculties and academic disciplines.
- 3- Time scope: The study was conducted during the second semester of the academic year (2020/2021 AD).

Terminology of study:

Effective Education:

Know (Adam, 2020) teaching Effective as: that style from education yummy leads to learning or collection better about road Direct interaction situations between the teacher and his students.

and knows (Al-Qa`oud & Abu Asba', 2017) teaching Effective as: process to organize expositions learn students Through it educated make them able on me acquisition Knowledge and formation of trends and development skills and calendar that A comprehensive, diversified, and continuous calendar so process Learning is learning tough situations.

The researcher defines it procedurally as: everything he plans teacher goals, activities, and methods teaching and means educational and methods Evaluation To implement lesson, malady to gain educated Knowledge and development understanding They have until it remains The effect of learning for the longest period possible, and then Evaluation Bezel Investigation That Planned goals.

Study method and procedure:

Study Approach:

The descriptive approach was used due to its suitability and the nature of the current study.

Study population and sample:

Study community: The study population consists of all students enrolled in Jordanian public universities during the second semester of the academic year (2020/2021 AD).

The study sample: The study sample consisted of (1000) male and female students from Al-Balqa Applied University from various disciplines and university colleges, who were selected by stratified random method, and the following table No. (1) shows the distribution of the sample according to the study variables.

Study tool:

To identify the elements of the effective educational and teaching process, the study tool was developed by referring to previous studies related to the subject of the current study as a study (AL-Momani,2022), a study (Khazay, 2020), a study (Al-Momani & Rababa, 2022), and a study (Al-Naddaf & Abu Zama', 2013), where the study, in its initial form, consisted of (25) paragraphs that measure the elements of the effective educational process; Where the five-point Likert scale was used in order to respond to the paragraphs of the questionnaire that was formulated positively, because it represents the practices of the effective educational and teaching process, and the response weights on the items were as shown in the following table (2):

Validity of the tool:

To ensure the validity of the study tool and the extent to which it measured what it was designed to measure, the researcher presented it to a committee consisting of (12) arbitrators from faculty members in the disciplines of curricula, teaching methods, educational psychology, measurement and evaluation at Al-Balqa Applied University and Yarmouk University, in order to express their opinions on an occasion The paragraphs of the subject of the study and making any other observations such as merging, adding and deleting some paragraphs; The approval rate of (80%) of the arbitrators was relied upon to make any amendment to the paragraphs; Where some paragraphs were merged and deleted so that the scale became composed of (20) paragraphs in its final form.

Tool stability:

The stability of the study tool was confirmed by using the test and re-test method (Test, Re-test) on a sample of (30) male and female students from the same study community but not from its sample, then the test was applied again after (14) days from the first application, where the total stability coefficient reached (0.89) and this was considered good for the purposes of the study.

Statistical manipulations:

To answer the study questions, use the Statistical Package Program for Social Sciences (SPSS 21) By using the following statistical treatments:

- 1- Arithmetic averages, percentage, and standard deviations.
- 2- a test (t-test)

3- one-way analysis of variance (One Way- ANOVA)

In order to judge the arithmetic averages, the degree was considered high in the category of arithmetic averages from (3.67 .).-5,00) and average in a category of (33, 2-66, 3) and low in the category of (1,00-2,33). According to the following statistical standard:

Results

In light of the objectives of the previous study, the researcher monitored the data and conducted a statistical analysis of the data. The following is a presentation of the results and their discussion according to the study sequence:

First: the results related to the first question of the study, which states: "What are the elements of the effective teaching and learning process from the point of view of Al-Balqa Applied University students?

To answer this question, the arithmetic averages and standard deviations were extracted for each paragraph of the scale and for the scale as a whole, and the following table No. (3) illustrates this.

It is clear from the previous table No. (3) that the arithmetic averages and standard deviations of the elements of the effective educational and teaching process from the students' point of view came at an average degree on the total score of the scale, where the arithmetic mean was (3.37) and with a standard deviation of (63); Where (5) items got a high score, (13) items got a medium score, and two items got a low score; Where the paragraph that states "the teacher explains the course content clearly to the students" ranked first with an arithmetic mean of (4.71) and a standard deviation of (0.54) to a high degree; Then followed in second place by the paragraph which states: The teacher helps students understand the content of the material With a mean of (4.52) and a standard deviation of (0.57) to a high degree; While came in the penultimate rank, which states: The teacher shows a clear desire to teach With a mean of (2.31) and a standard deviation of (0.69) and at a low degree, and came in the last place the paragraph which states: The teacher uses feedback to the students With an arithmetic mean of (2.18) and a standard deviation of (0.67) and to a low degree.

The researcher attributes this to the positive impact resulting from the students' responses to the teaching method and its clarity, and thus it is reflected in the students' understanding appropriately. This result can also be attributed to the existence of a real desire among the faculty members at the university to be able to assume responsibility in the educational process, which has a positive impact on students; Also, directing praise from the teacher to the student is one of the basics that must be observed in the educational process, which plays a significant impact in improving the psychological state of students and informing them of the importance of their performance, which contributes to the continuation of the effort made by the student to maintain his position in front of the teacher and students; This result agreed with the results of the study of both(Khazay, 2020)And the(Akl, 2019)And the(Jabouri, 2016)And the(Asiri2013).

Second: The results related to the second question of the study, which states: "Are there statistically significant differences at the significance level ($\alpha = 0.05$) in the elements of the effective educational and teaching process from the perspective of Al Balqa Applied University students, which are attributed to the gender variable (male, female)?

To answer this question, a test was used(T-Test) to indicate the differences between groups and the following table No. (4) explains this:

Table No. (4) indicates that there are no statistically significant differences in the total score of the elements of the effective educational and teaching process from the point of view of the students of Al-Balqa Applied University, which are attributed to the gender variable (males, females), and this indicates that the gender variable has no clear impact on the students' assessment The degree to which faculty members practice the elements of the learning, teaching and teaching process, where the researcher believes that teachers practice their work according to similar educational plans and facilities for both sexes, and therefore the estimates were similar.

Third: The results related to the third question of the study, which states: "Are there statistically significant differences at the significance level ($\alpha = 0.05$) in the elements of the effective educational and teaching process from the perspective of Al Balqa Applied University students, which are attributed to the student's degree variable (intermediate diploma, bachelor's degree) ?

To answer this question, a test (T-test) to indicate the differences between groups, and the following table No. (5) shows this:

Table No. (5) indicates that there are no statistically significant differences in the total score Elements of the effective educational and teaching process from the point of view of Al-Balqa Applied University students Which is attributed to the student's degree variable (intermediate diploma, bachelor's degree), and this indicates that the scientific degree in which the student studies have no clear impact on the students' assessment of the degree to which faculty members practice the elements of the learning, teaching and teaching process, and the researcher believes that teachers are the same who teach students Whether at the diploma or bachelor's level, students look to teachers at the same level.

Recommendations:

In light of the study objectives and results, the researcher recommends the following:

- 1- Relying on the study scale items used in determining the elements of the effective educational and teaching process, as well as preparing and motivating teaching contents at the university level.
- 2- The need to take into account the results of this study for the evaluation process of faculty members at Al-Balqa Applied University in particular and Jordanian universities in general.
- 3- The need to take into account the results of the study in order to prepare the faculty members in universities and qualify them well in line with the principles of continuous professional development.

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
